The Act and regulations may be accessed at the GIPSA web site located at <http://www.usda.gov/gipsa/>. The Packers and Stockyards Act requires you to keep proper books and records covering your business and to submit an annual report of your operations to the office of the area supervisor.

The enclosed sample annual report form is NOT to be executed. However, it will help you to install a system of records, which will contain the necessary information required in your annual reports. Current copies of the report form will be mailed to you after the close of this calendar year. If you conduct your operations on a calendar-year basis, the report is due on April 15, following the close of the calendar year. If your operations are conducted on a fiscal-year basis, the report is due 90 days following the close of the fiscal year.
